## **RESOLUTION TWO**

SUMMARY: To order the Kwantlen First Nation Indian Act Band Council to bring the new Governance Code to a vote of the people within 90 days.

## **WHEREAS**

- 1. Starting in March, 2019, the Kwantlen people and Band Council engaged in good faith consultations to create a written Governance Code for the Kwantlen First Nation.
- In May, 2021, Four Directions Management Services presented the conclusions of the consultations to the Kwantlen people. The consensus they produced indicated that Kwantlen people wanted a symbolic Hereditary Chief and an elected Band Council with more members.
- 3. For more than 1 year, the Band Council has refused to present the new Governance Code to the people.
- 4. The work, development, and community harmony of the Kwantlen First Nation is all held back by the lack of legitimacy in the current band government.

## **BE IT RESOLVED THAT -**

- A. The Band Council is ordered to present the new Governance Code to the people within 10 days.
- B. The Governance Code must be consistent with the consensus produced by Four Directions in May 2021, and include a symbolic Hereditary Chief, and an enlarged elected Band Council.
- C. The Band Council must hold a referendum on the new Custom Governance Code within 90 days.
- D. The Referendum will be conducted per the referendum regulations included in the Land Code.
